Professor Joseph Sarkis, Foisie Business School at Worcester Polytechnic Institute, USA. Editor and Editorial Advisory Board member of several leading journals in the Supply Chain Management field.

Professor Marina Jirotko, Oxford Internet Institute, University of Oxford, UK. Has given expert opinions to House of Lords Select Committees and All-Party Parliamentary Group. She is a Board Member of the Society for Computers and Law, and part of the UK EPSRC (Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council) Digital Economy theme.

Terrell Ward Bynum, Southern Connecticut State University, USA. Best known as a pioneer and historian in the field of computer and information ethics; for his achievements in that field, he was awarded the Barwise Prize of the American Philosophical Association, the Weizenbaum Award of the International Society for Ethics and Information Technology, and the 2011 Covey Award of the International Association for Computing and Philosophy.
