'The capacity to aspire' refers to aspirations of people to escape conditions of poverty and deprivation






Future-oriented cultural capacity

Objects



Immediate objects of aspiration are more about wants (designer clothing, latest gadgets)



Intermediate objects of aspiration provide long-term rewards with sustained effort

Agency



Agentic capabilities strengthen active self-formation and discipline



Agentic transactions involve the use of social networks, historical narratives and role models for youth

Windows provide a glimpse of the future, allowing youth to anticipate and plan ahead



Social safety nets provide guarantees that allow youth to take prepared risks

Spaces



Imposed spaces are composed of race, class, age, gender and sexual orientation, and vary according to time, location and the individual



Intended spaces focus on the horizon, the spaces of the future and the ethics of possibility, fed by hope and imagination
